The International College is an innovative liberal arts based College that strives to redefine how students see and interact with the world. Experiential Learning

Flexibility of course selections at Tunghai International College:

- General education courses taught in English (topics: Society, Culture, and Political History of Taiwan, East Asian Religions, Environmental Science)
- Business courses taught in English
- Advanced courses/internships taught in English (Internships can be repeated or extended pending visa approval and local conditions)
- Chinese language courses and complimentary culture classes through the Chinese Language Center (assigned based on a placement test)
- A core faculty of domestic and international professors, and local CSL (Chinese as a Second Language) instructors

In 2014 Tunghai University, continuing its long tradition of international education, launched the International College. The International College only offers programs taught entirely in Chinese, promotes the liberal arts and sustainability studies, and embodies the ideals of humanism and professionalism.

With an emphasis on cross-cultural communication, global leadership, and holistic fundamental education, the International College has designed a general education curriculum with coursework in contemporary trends in politics, economics and society; arts and letters; ecology and sustainability; and global citizenship for the 21st century. THU's International College is the first English-Immersion undergraduate program in Taiwan. Moreover, the International College is collaborating with overseas partners that share Tunghai's commitment to professional studies with a liberal arts foundation. Taiwanese students and their foreign counterparts are brought together under an English-based learning and living environment. Through in-class lectures, discussions and oral presentation, and overseas studies, our students can experience different cultures and study global issues with classmates from around the world.

A few scholarship opportunities are now available to students studying in the International College. International students will be eligible to receive scholarship to help support their study in the International Business Administration or Sustainable Sciences and Engineering programs. In

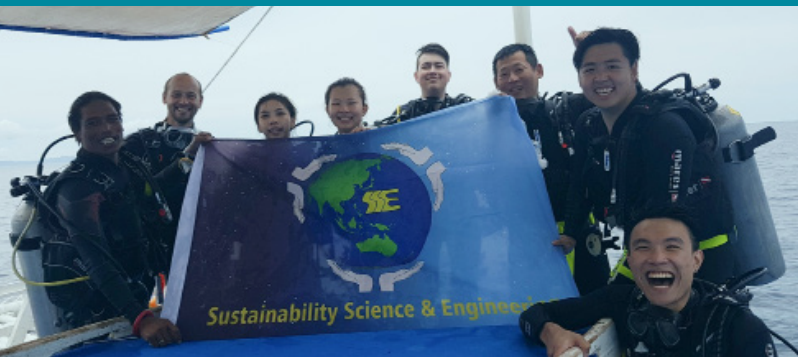

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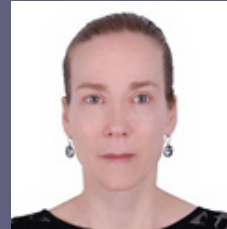
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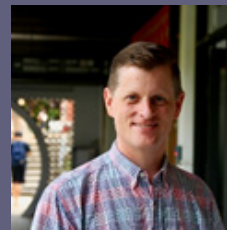

A Variety of Study Abroad Options

Opportunity	Time Overseas	Benefits
Student Exchange Programs	1 or 2 Semesters	Spend one or two semesters overseas at a particular university and receive degree-required credits from the partner university, while living and traveling in a foreign country
Short Term Courses and Study Tours	2 to 6 Weeks	Take specialized courses at partner universities; academic credits can be granted (subject to faculty approval). Usually fee-based but fee reduction is negotiable

University of Rhode

University of Rhode Island (URI) is an American public university located in Kingston, Rhode Island. The university was established in 1892. It has a total undergraduate enrollment of 13,641 students, and is nestled in a rural setting. IBA students interested in participating in the 2+2 program at URI will enroll in the URI College of Business Administration, where they can choose to focus their studies in Accounting, Entrepreneurial Management, Finance, General Business, Global Business, or Marketing and Supply Chain Management.



Trinity

Trinity University is a small private liberal arts college located in San Antonio, Texas. The university was founded in 1869, and has a total undergraduate enrollment of 2,273 students. The campus is located near San Antonio's culturally rich downtown, giving students the opportunity to experience urban life in the U.S. Trinity University has consistently been well regarded, and was ranked as #1 in the 2017 edition of Best Colleges in Regional Universities West. IBA students interested in participating in the 2+2 program at Trinity will study in Trinity's School of Business, Department of Business Administration.

Nottingham Trent

Nottingham Trent University is a public university located in Nottingham, England. The university was founded in 1992 and has a total undergraduate enrollment of 21,855. The university's main campus is located in Nottingham's city center, offering student access to a historical urban environment. IBA students interested in participating in the 3+1 program at Nottingham Trent will study under the University's International Business Management program, which aims to provide students with a comprehensive education in business theory and core management skills.





ESC Rennes School of

ESC Rennes School of Business is a French business school located in Rennes, France. Rennes offers a student city environment, and is located in the West of France. The school was founded in 1990 and has 4,330 students, 50% of which are international students. The courses at Rennes School of Business are taught in English, but there are still many opportunities for students to study and improve their French language if they so desire. The international staff and student body gives ESC Rennes School of Business a strong international environment for student to grow as international business leaders.

Temple

Temple University is a perfect fit for students who want that full graduate experience; vibrant city life, excellent education, and school name recognition. The green campus is situated snugly near the center of Philadelphia, the fifth largest city in the United States, making it easy for students to access city amenities and popular spots in the downtown area. The Temple graduate student body is large, reaching more than 9,000, guaranteeing professors and students are diverse in studies and interests. In terms of business studies, the Temple Fox Business School was ranked in the top twenty nationwide by U.S. News & World Report. 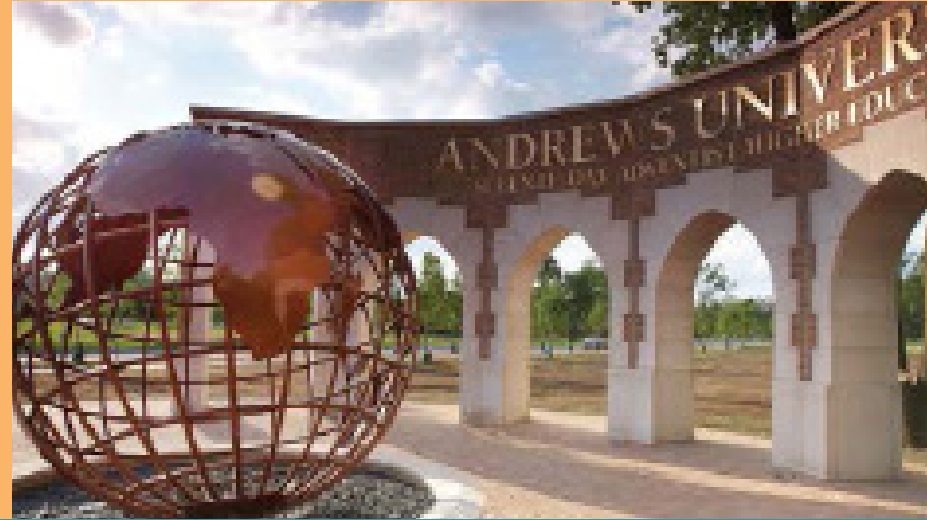


University of New South Wales

The University of New South Wales is regarded as one of the country's leading universities. In 2016, it was the 1st university preference for high school students in the State of New South Wales. In the 2016 QS World University Rankings UNSW was ranked globally as 49th overall, 11th in the world for Accounting and Finance (1st in Australia), 14th for law (3rd in Australia), and 16th in civil and structural engineering (1st in Australia). The university comprises eight College, through which it offers bachelor, master and doctoral degrees. Students who apply this program have to study in UNSW in senior year and students whose senior final grade meets the qualification set by UNSW can study the master program in UNSW.

Andrews

Andrews University is an American private university located in Barren Springs, Michigan, a small village nestled in northern America. The university was founded in 1874 and boasts a student body of 3,366. Students interested in participating in the International College's 3.5 +1.5 program with Andrews University will spend three and a half years studying at the International College in Tunghai and one and a half years studying at Andrews University. After successful completion of the program, the student will be awarded with both a bachelor and a masters degree in International Business



How It Works:

1. After 2 years of study at Tunghai University, THU students will transfer to a partner institution to complete the bachelor's degree within the next two years (2+2).
2. THU applicants (2+2) must submit the official results of the TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) or the IELTS (International English Language Testing System), or the Pearson Test of English taken within the past two years. Different dual degree programs have different requirement of TOEFL iBT and IELTS score.
3. THU applicants (2+2) must submit an official transcript demonstrating completion of coursework equivalent to the partner institution's General Education and major requirement through the sophomore year. The Office of Admissions at the partner institution must approve all transfer credit.
4. (2+2) THU students will pay THU tuition and fees during the first two years of their Bachelor's program at THU. They will pay THU fees as well as tuition and fees to the partner institution during their second two years of study (2+2) at the partner institution.
5. Each student is responsible for living expenses, including during extended academic recess (e.g., summer, winter and spring breaks), all transportation costs, books and supplies, health insurance, and personal and incidental expenses.

Future Options

Further Academic Study

Students are encouraged to pursue master's and doctoral degrees for careers in business, research, and education. THU has collaborated with overseas partner universities to offer 3+2 dual-degree programs allowing International College students to fast-track advanced degrees.

Professional Development

Most International College graduates will go straight into industry in management roles. They will be trained to put into practice what they have learned at school to work in a variety of professions including marketing, advertising, finance, international business, project management, human resources management, health care administration, and accounting and tax services. With the cultivation of their English communication and presentation skills and abilities, International College graduates will enter the job market with confidence and skill.



Admission

1. Taiwanese Students: Through application screening (personal application), entrance examination, special admission or shining star.
2. Foreign Students: Through online application. Applicants are required to provide proof of English language proficiency.

Tuition and Fees:

Tuition is approximately USD 2,300 per semester and living costs are approximately USD 3,000 per 6 months.
